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### OUR CAMPAIGNS

#### Blue Badge Abuse

DMUK is the charity taking the lead when it comes to enforcement of the Blue Badge Scheme. We constantly seek to ensure the Blue Badge scheme is enforced and abuse is stamped out by working with both local authorities and private operators.

#### Parking

From the lack of parking at healthcare facilities to parking equipment that is difficult or impossible for disabled drivers to use - we put your point of view to councils and companies. We are working with the British Parking Association and Department for Transport to resolve issues that affect our members.

#### Refuelling at Petrol Stations

Automated petrol stations can prevent disabled motorists from refuelling. We are working with the UK petrol industry to introduce a system that allows disabled people to refuel their vehicle independently.

#### Disabled Parking Accreditation

Disabled Motoring UK runs the parking standard called the Disabled Parking Accreditation (DPA) which is a recognised certification mark. The DPA is primarily aimed at improving parking for disabled people and reducing abuse of disabled parking bays.

In order to qualify for the DPA a car park must meet the accreditation criteria which include; accessible bays, clear signage, ease of access, good lighting, easy entry to the car park, accessible payment machines, alternative payment methods, concessions and bay enforcement.

The idea for the DPA was born out of the frustrations that DMUK members have when trying to park. DMUK hopes that car parks across the country will take up this accreditation and, by doing so, demonstrate to their customers that they are committed to creating high quality parking facilities for disabled people.
